Dear parents and carers,

As you may be aware, we have been introducing more technology to our Key Stage 2 classrooms – providing enough tablets for every pupil from Year 3 to Year 6. These tablets belong to the school, though we will allocate one for each pupil to use in order to get the full benefit out of it.

To begin with, we will be using them at school only but we would also like to be able to send the tablet home with pupils so that they can use them to access further learning and enhance our homework offer.

There will be no cost to you for this, however, before we can send the devices home, we need you to agree to our Acceptable Use and Loan Agreement. We understand that many of you may have completed a similar agreement last year, but we are asking for you to complete a new one each year to keep our records up to date.

Completing the agreement doesn't mean that your pupil will immediately bring home a device. The teacher in their class will decide when it's appropriate and necessary to take this step. Please complete the agreement as soon as possible though, so that your child can bring the device home when it's time.
